Waterfall in Desa Les

per car (max. 6 persons) **IDR 250.000**

Visit "Les" waterfall close to our village – just a short trek from the waterfall entrance car park, take a refreshing dip under the natural, cascading waterfall in beautiful tropical surroundings.

Boat Trips

You may choose from the following options:

- Start in the early morning to see the beautiful sunrise – you might even meet dolphins.
- Join the fishermen on their daily traditional fishing tour and bring the catch of the day.
- Have your individual boat trip along the coast line – ideal for snorkelling in the clear water.

Surya Indigo Traditional Weaving

per car (max. 5 persons) **IDR 300.000**

Set in a tropical garden, including dye plants, members of Pacung village carry out different stages of textile production by hand, including the production of their own cotton thread. Pak Nyoman Sarmika, the owner, can arrange demonstrations and show you around his workshop and garden, discussing the traditional methods of the dyeing and fixing process, as well as the various plants used. Fabrics include cottons and silks and combinations of both, which you may also purchase.

Ubud

The artist's colony Ubud has a lot to offer including local arts & crafts, traditional markets and the famous monkey forest. However, Ubud is also the Bali's hub for Yoga, Yoga fashion, healing, organic and raw food restaurants & cafes. You may also make a stop along the way at "Tirta Empul" temple for a cleansing ritual.

Buddhist Monastery & Hot Springs in Banjar

This Buddhist monastery in the West of the island is the most beautiful in all Bali. The hot springs of Serririt are known for their healing power and they are a popular destination for vacationers.

Tamblingan "Twin Lakes" & Lovina

Enjoy a wonderful view at the Lake Buyan and Lake Tamblingan. In Lovina you can find numerous restaurants, bars and small shops.

Kintamani – Mt. Batur Volcano & Lake Batur

Have lunch in a restaurant with a breathtaking view of the volcano and Lake Batur.

Waterpalace in Tirtagangga

Bali is famous for its wonderful rice terraces that you see on the way to the beautiful water palace King, the „Tirtagangga“ (holy water of the Ganges). A guided tour through the wonderful gardens is very interesting.

“Besakih” – The mother Temple of Bali

Visit the most wonderful temple of the island – the great pride of the Balinese people. An excursion to the most important temple of Bali gives you an insight into the religious culture of this island. The colorful ceremonies are an unforgettable experience.

Waterfall “Git-Git”

& Water Temple “Ulun Danu Beratan” in Bedugul

The highest waterfall (30m) of all Bali is located at the road from Singaraja to Lake Beratan in the North of Bali. You find the temple „Pura Ulun Danu“ on a small island on the lake. The lake Beratan is known to be holy and to contain magical power.

The big botanical garden of Bedugul provides more than 650 different kinds of trees, many tropical plants and a wonderful collection of Orchids on a terrain of 1,5 km².

Traditional "Bali Aga" Village in Tenganan

This is the home of the 'Bali Aga', the original inhabitants of Bali, where they weave the traditional "Ikat" cloth.

Snorkelling & Diving in Amed

Enjoy the colourful underwater world in Amed. There is a lot to discover in the Japanese ship wreck. On site there is the possibility to rent equipment for snorkelling and diving.

Menjangan Island

In the wonderful nature reserve of Menjangan Island you dive in a colourful magical world of corals and tropical fish. A local guide will accompany the snorkel or dive trip. Equipment can be rented on site. Also trekking tours with a guide can be booked in Menjangan. Here one still finds an intact nature – rare animals and plants and an incredible jungle.
